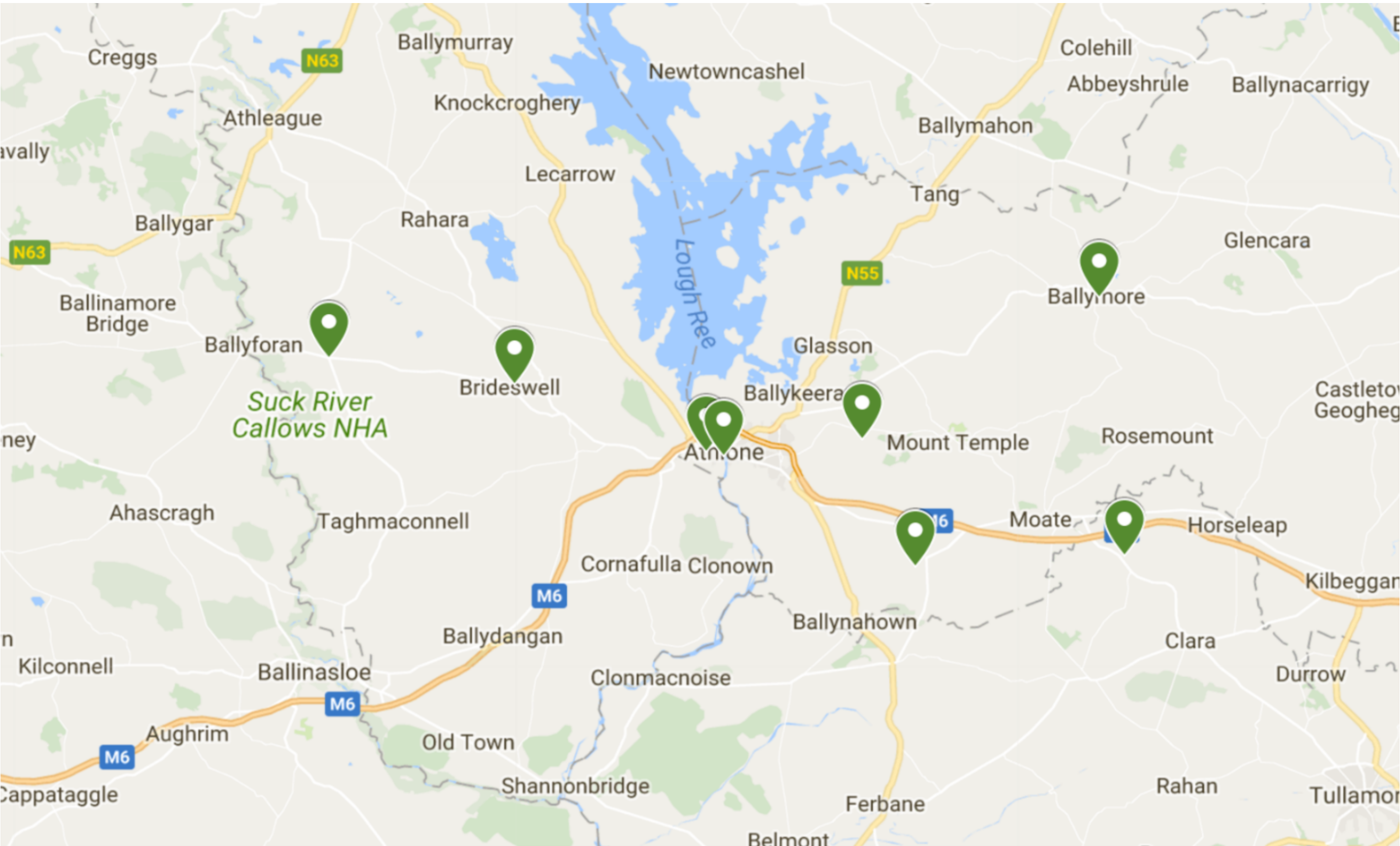

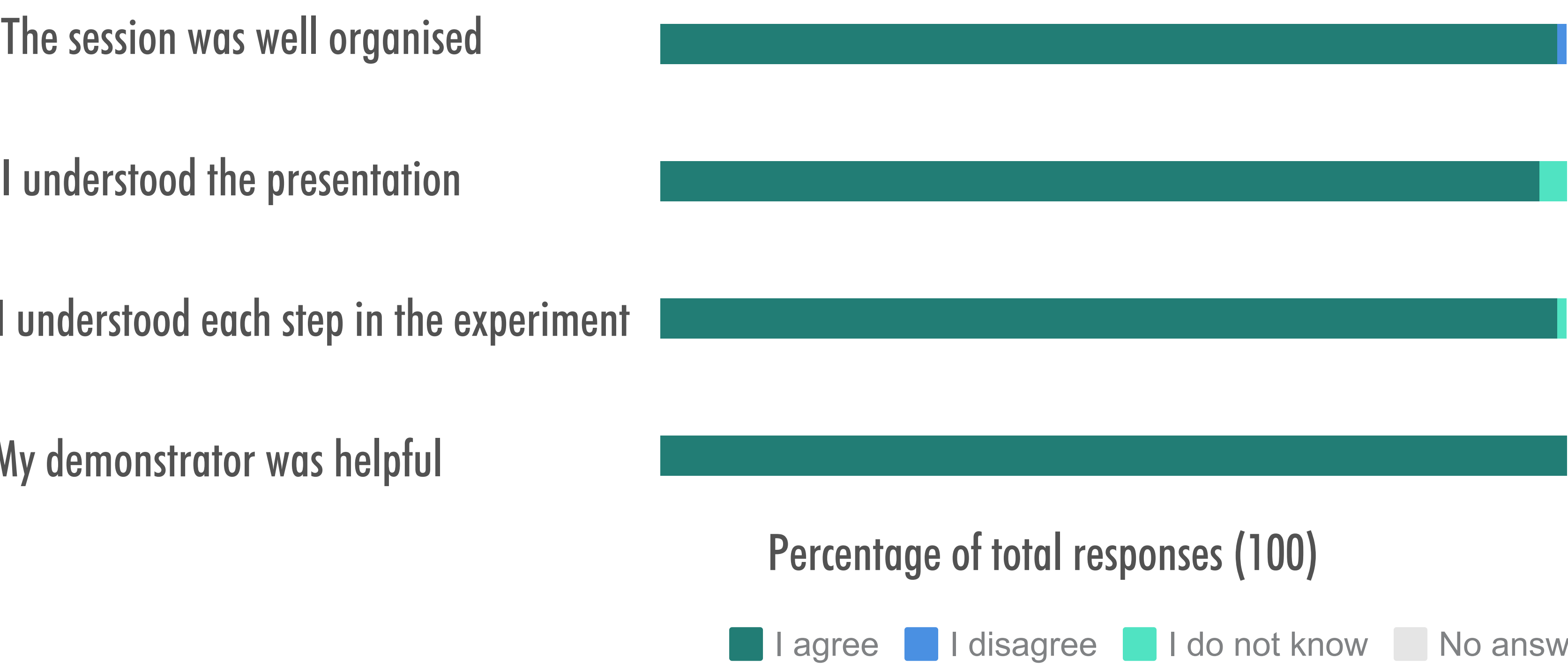

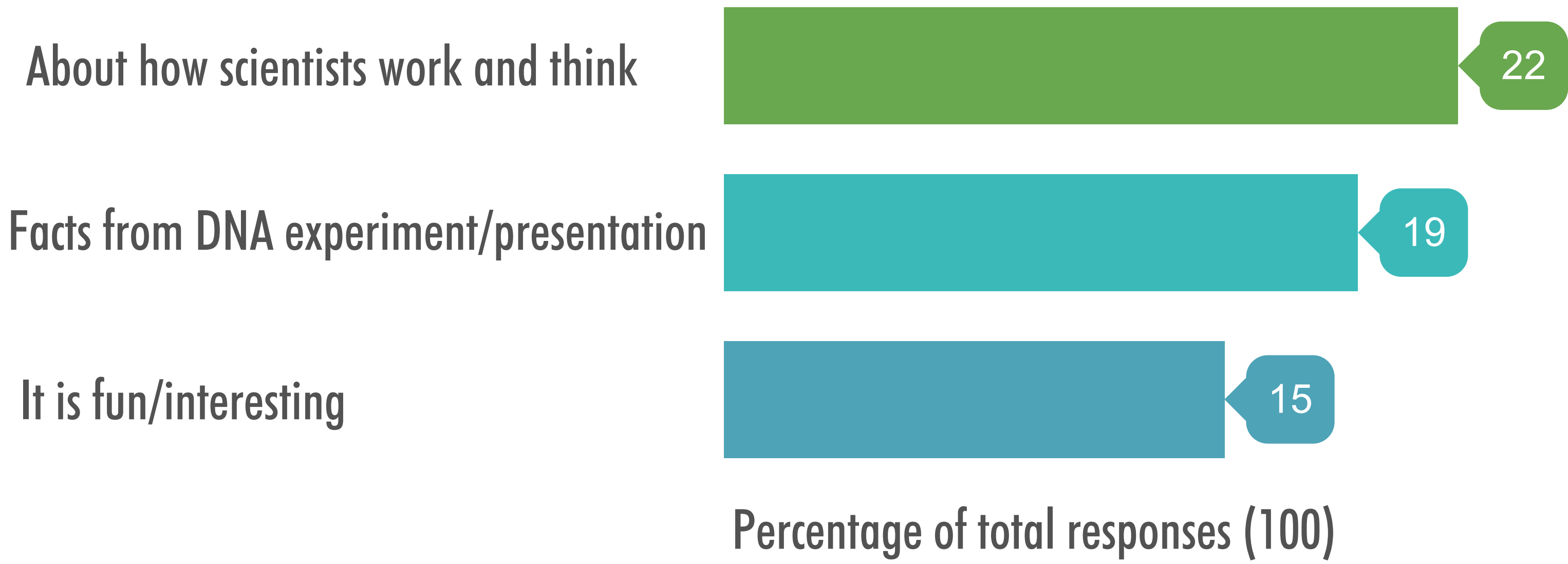
Children's feedback

"I liked the end when we built the DNA statue because everyone was working together, it was fun and there was no arguing!"

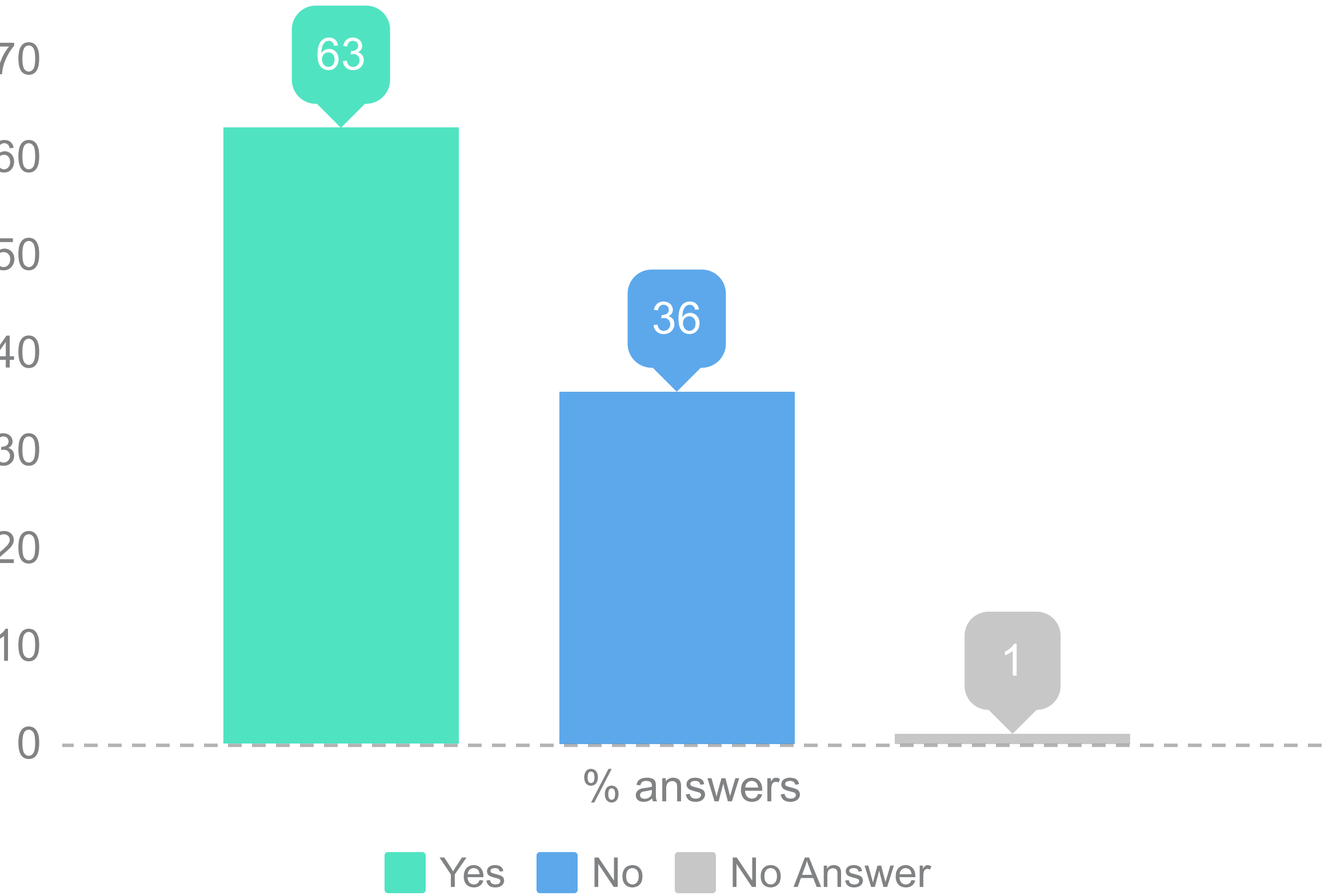
What new thing did you learn about science? (Top 3 answers)



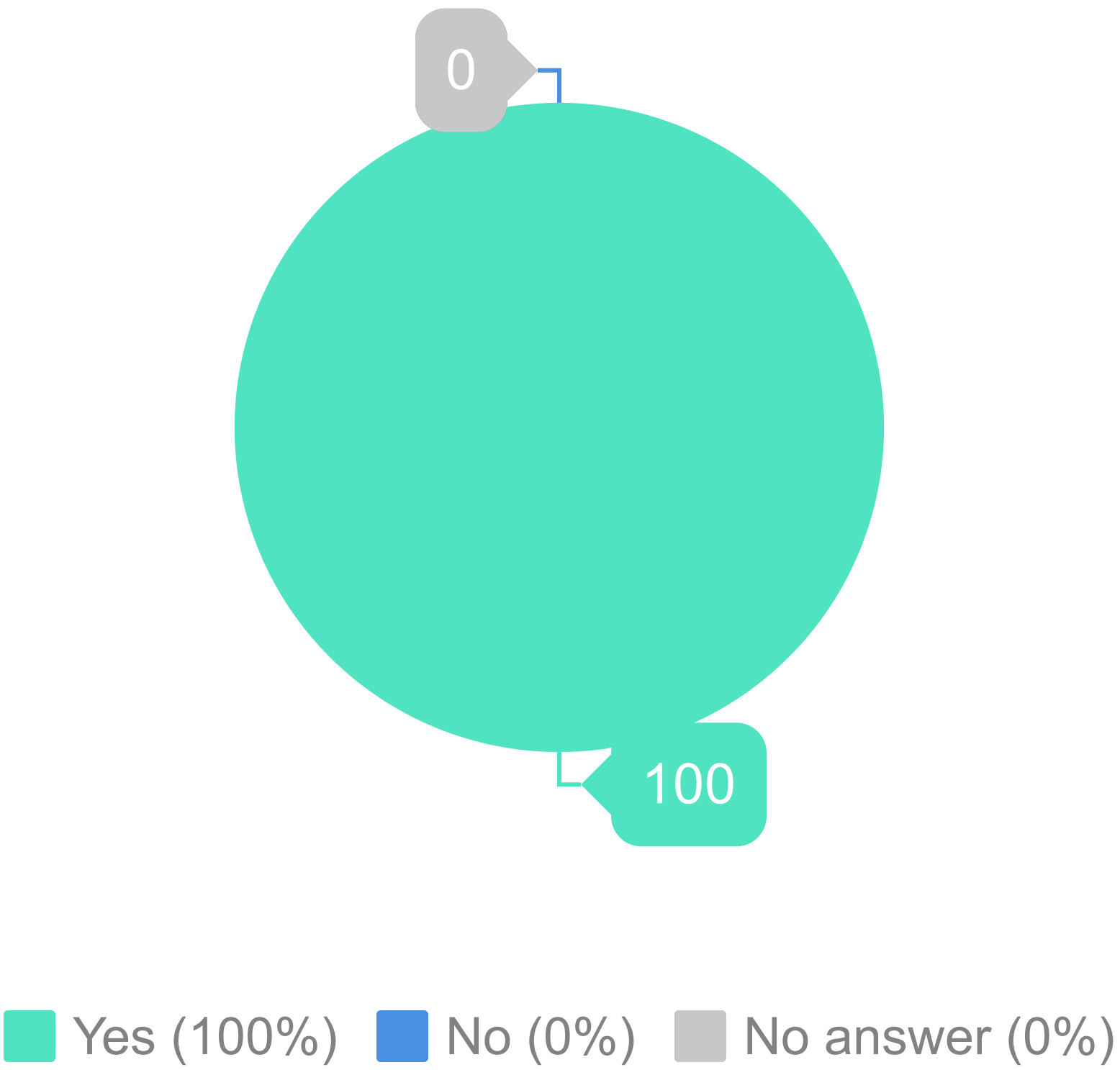
"I liked meeting the cell explorers because they were very helpful and if you didn't understand something they were ready to help with a nice attitude"

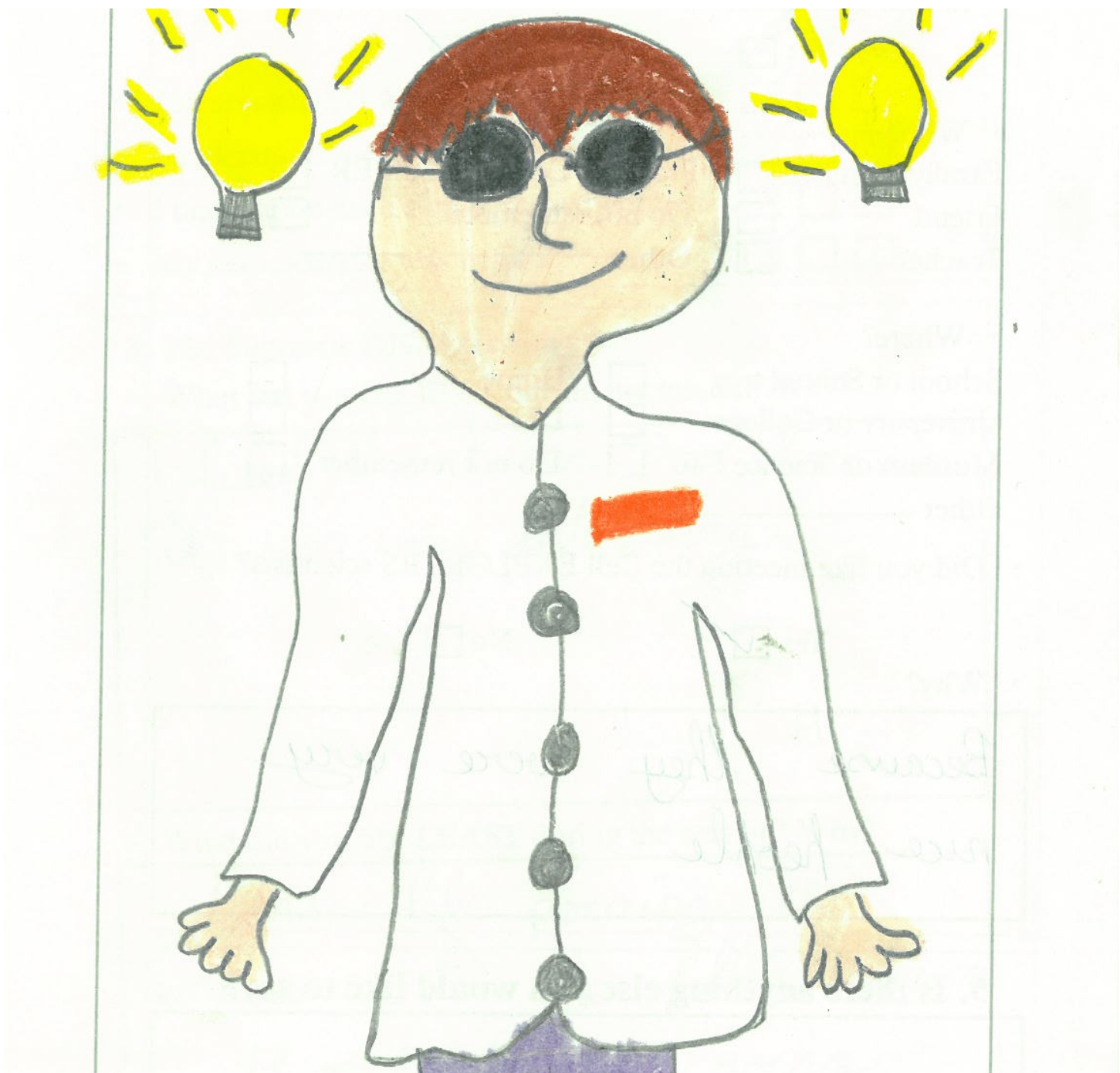
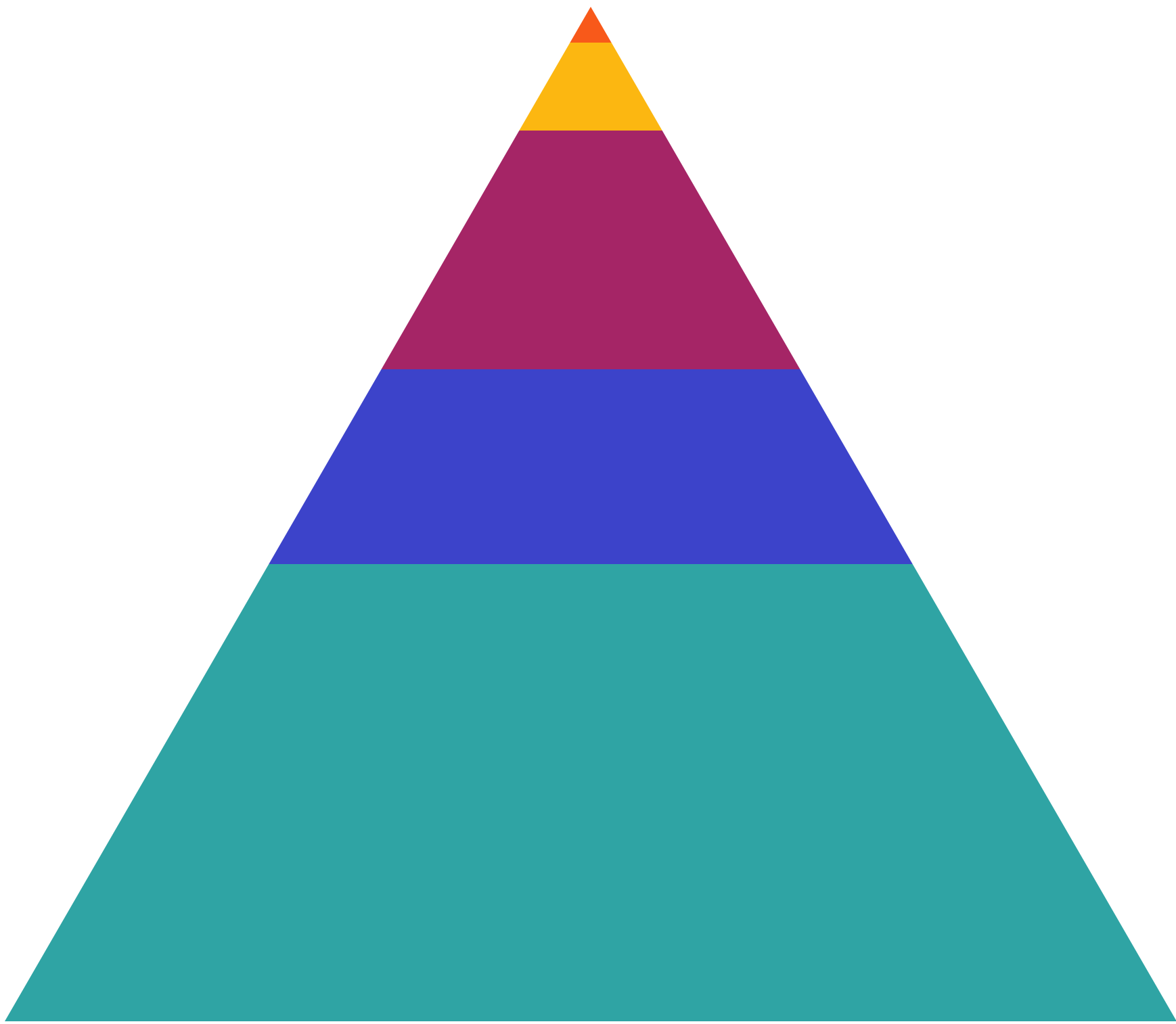
Had you met a scientist before?
