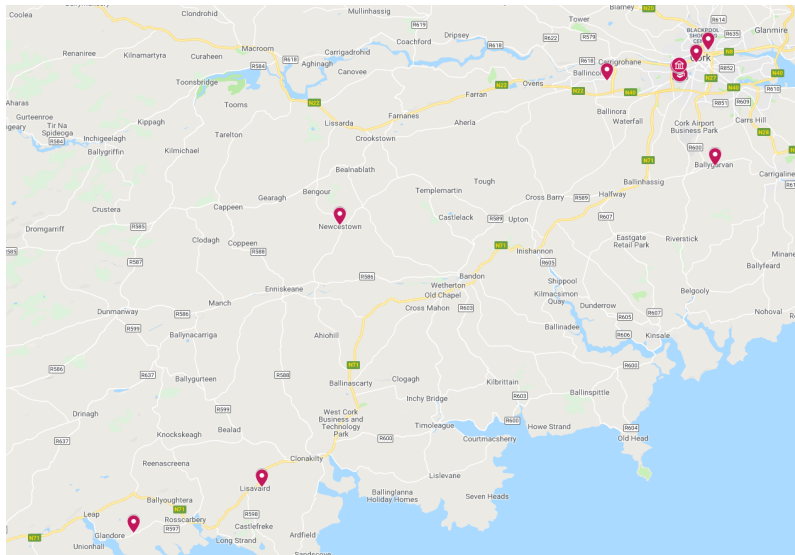

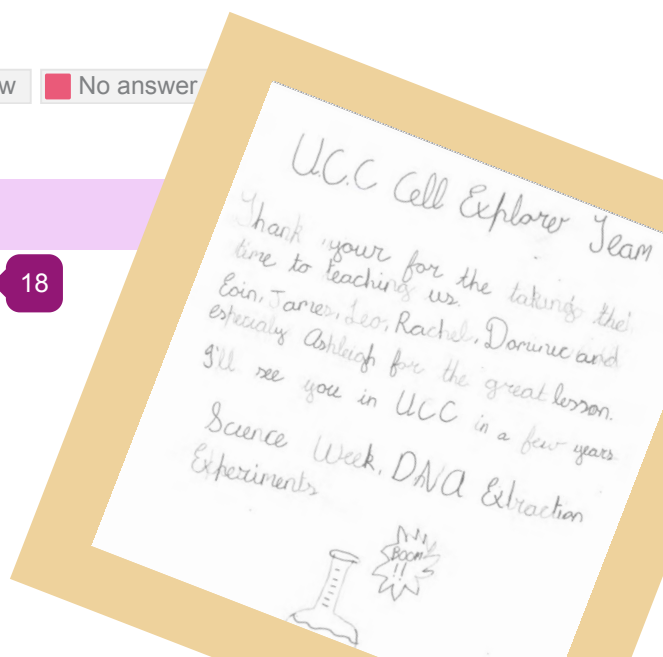

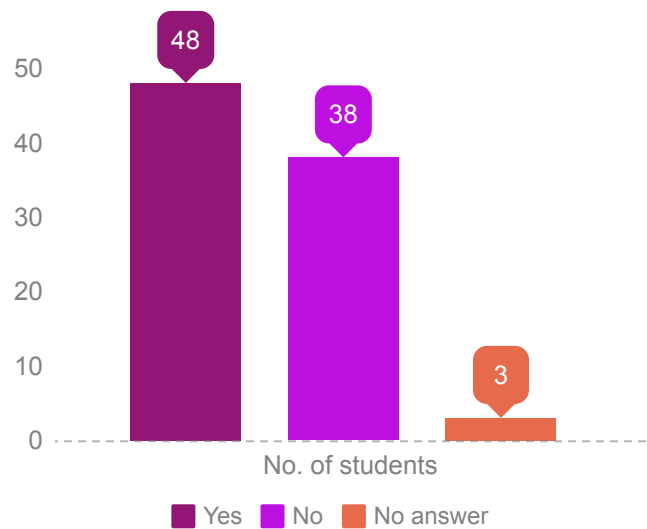

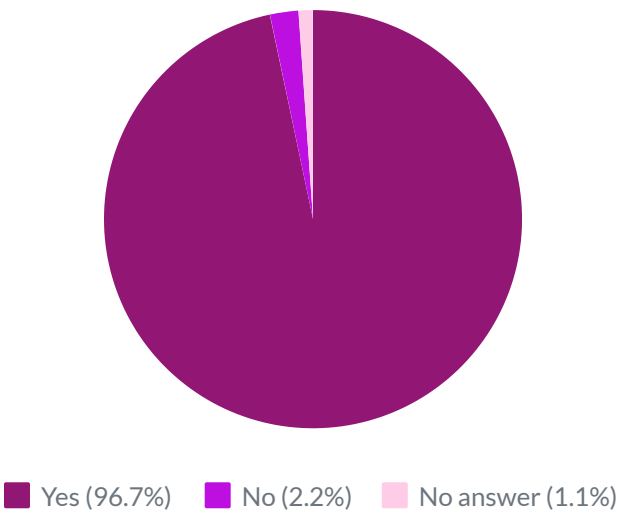


Meeting the Cell EXPLORERS UCC scientists

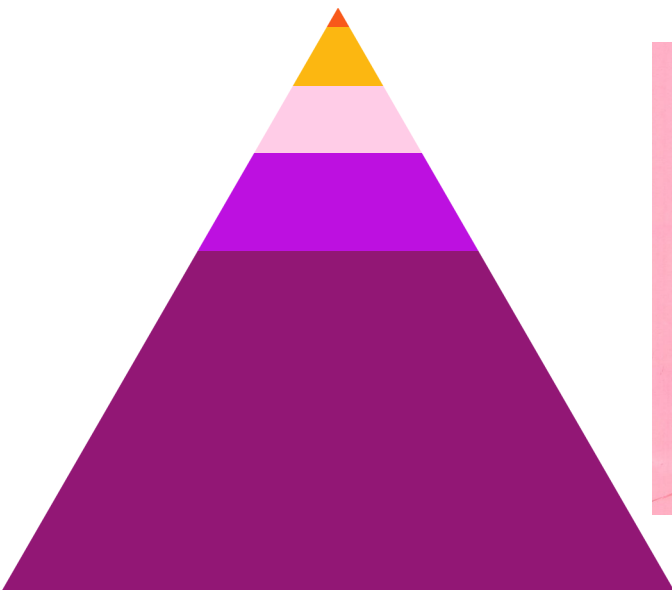
Had you met a scientist before?
