



My teacher was helpful




What did you like BEST? (Top 3 answers)

I did the experiment myself








Session was well organised and presented


Training materials enabled me to run the session effectively

Session content well adapted to age group



Count of teachers (N=23) that ranked aspects 1st, 2nd and 3rd




Teacher's comments on perceived impact reflect authenticity of session

Percentage of total survey responses (n=23)






