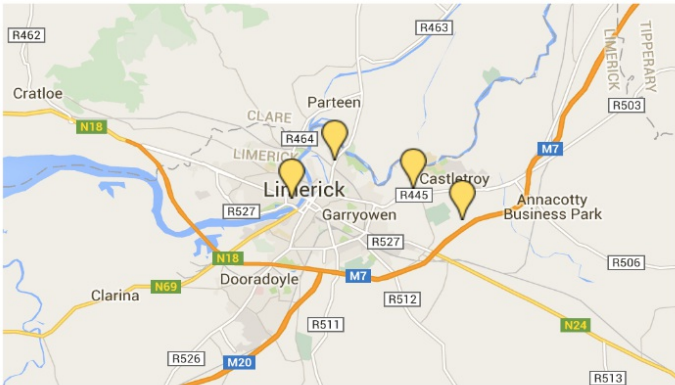

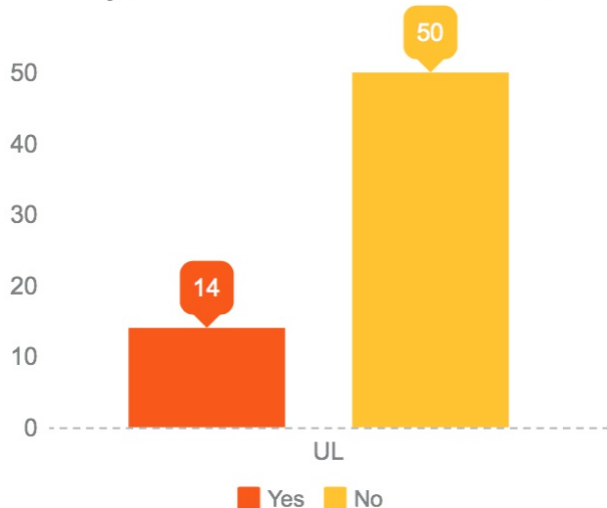

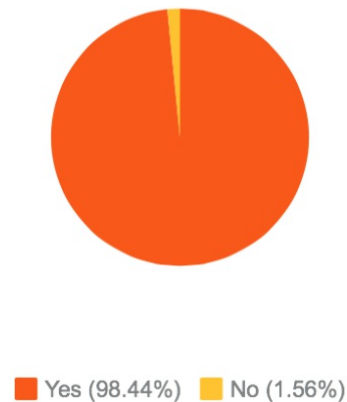

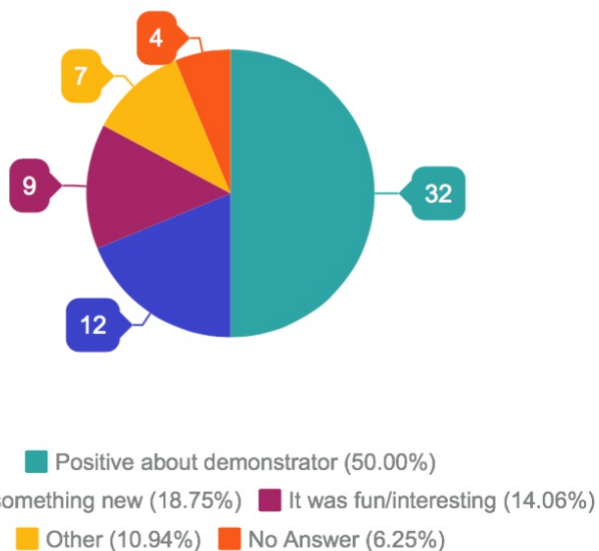
Had you met a scientist before?
